Located in the lieu-dit "Perrières dessous", this parcel is in the South of Meursault, just next to Puligny-Montrachet.

It is a small, very stony "clos" (walled vineyard) because of its proximity to an old quarry.

Sun exposure is perfect, well protected from the wind; heat is incremented by the sun reflection sur les on the numerous stones.

Meursault Perrières is an astonishing structured wine, powerful on one hand, mineral on the other hand, and the ampleness et une longueur in the mouth is unrivalled.

It is a wine for long ageing (minimum 6-10 years), sometimes more than 20 years.

Les Pellans : south part of Meursault, near Meursault Charmes premier cru, au sud de Meursault, next to Puligny-Montrachet, gravely soils.

Les Chaumes de Narvaux : very stony soil, situated between Les Narvaux and Blagny, at the top of the slope.

Usually, Meursault Pierre MOREY comes from blending of these 3 lieux-dits, giving a well-balanced and typical wine from Meursault : dry and mellow at once, ample, racy and fruity.

All the vineyards from Domaine Pierre MOREY producing Bourgogne Aligoté are located in the Meursault area in relatively deep, clay and chalk soils.

Aligoté is a Burgundian variety (Kir is a traditional Burgundian aperitif made with Bourgogne Aligoté plus blackcurrent liqueur).

Bourgogne Aligoté is a dry wine, with a good acidity and a medium strength. Maturing is mostly done in tanks during 12 months, to promote freshness and ses notes fruitées.

Usually, Bourgogne Aligoté is an early wine but coming from Domaine Pierre MOREY, it can be kept for many years!



We bought this vineyard at the end of 2003 in lieu-dit Les Pétures, in the North of Meursault (even if the name is VOLNAY Santenots, this premier cru is completely produced in the Meursault area).

Located in the middle of the slope, the parcel is very well protected from the wind. Soils are rather shallow, very red and have a very delicate structure which is easy to work (ploughing,...)

From 1999 to 2003 included, Volnay Santenots was produced under the Morey-Blanc label. Beginning with the 2004 harvest, it is a biodynamic wine from Domaine Pierre MOREY. Allying finesse and elegance, is velvety (soft in the mouth) and heady, Volnay Santenots is a relatively rich wine.

Located in the North Meursault area, next to the Volnay Santenots premier cru appellation, Les Durots have soils that are deep, poor and stony (more clay than chalk).

The wines have a beautiful colour intensity, they are powerful, robust and tannic so the stiffness in their youth needs (a long) time to soften.

This is a wine that needs time to fully develop its potential. Optimal cellaring time should be from 10 or 15 years.

Domaine Pierre MOREY cultivates several little plots in 6 lieux-dits distributed in the heart of the appellation and all around the village. Some plots have red soils, others are more chalky, with a lot of stones.

Blending of these vineyards (slope and gentle-slope) produces a charming wine which is soft in the mouth from its youth. In addition to the beautiful expression of red fruits, there is a good tannin balance, which suggests that these wines will taste best if aged from 5 to 8 years, in most vintages.

Meursault "Les Narvaux" is a flattering wine, well balanced, with white flowers aromas, almond smell, and good length. Thanks to a beautiful minerality, "Les Narvaux" ages reaaly well. It is one of the best lieux-dits of Meursault village appellation.

French proverb : " Who never drank Meursault, doesn't know the value of Meursault ! "Qui n'a jamais bu de Narvaux Ne sait ce que Meursault vaut!







The Italian doctor, Augustino Mazzoli, astonished by the beauty of the town of Beaune, decided to set up home there and became one of the first doctors of the Hôtel-Dieu, practising until his death in 1505. One of his descendants, whose name was made french, the magistrate Jéhan de Massol bequeated upon his death in 1669 a collection of works of art.

Since its foundation during 15th Century by Nicolas Rolin and his wife Guigone de Salins, the Hospital has beenfunded by legacies and gifts; and became a beautiful vineyard estate. From 1859, the wines of the Hospices are sold by auction to improve the new hospital and keep the old buildings like « Hôtel-Dieu ».

The most famous Côte de Beaune "terroir" is named Montrachet because of the name of the hill "Mont Rachaz(t)" (= denued mountain). This appellation area is only 8 hectares.

Its fullness and balance are unrivalled, it is the most magic wine in Burgundy.

Usually spectacular in its youth, it can age during decades.
